

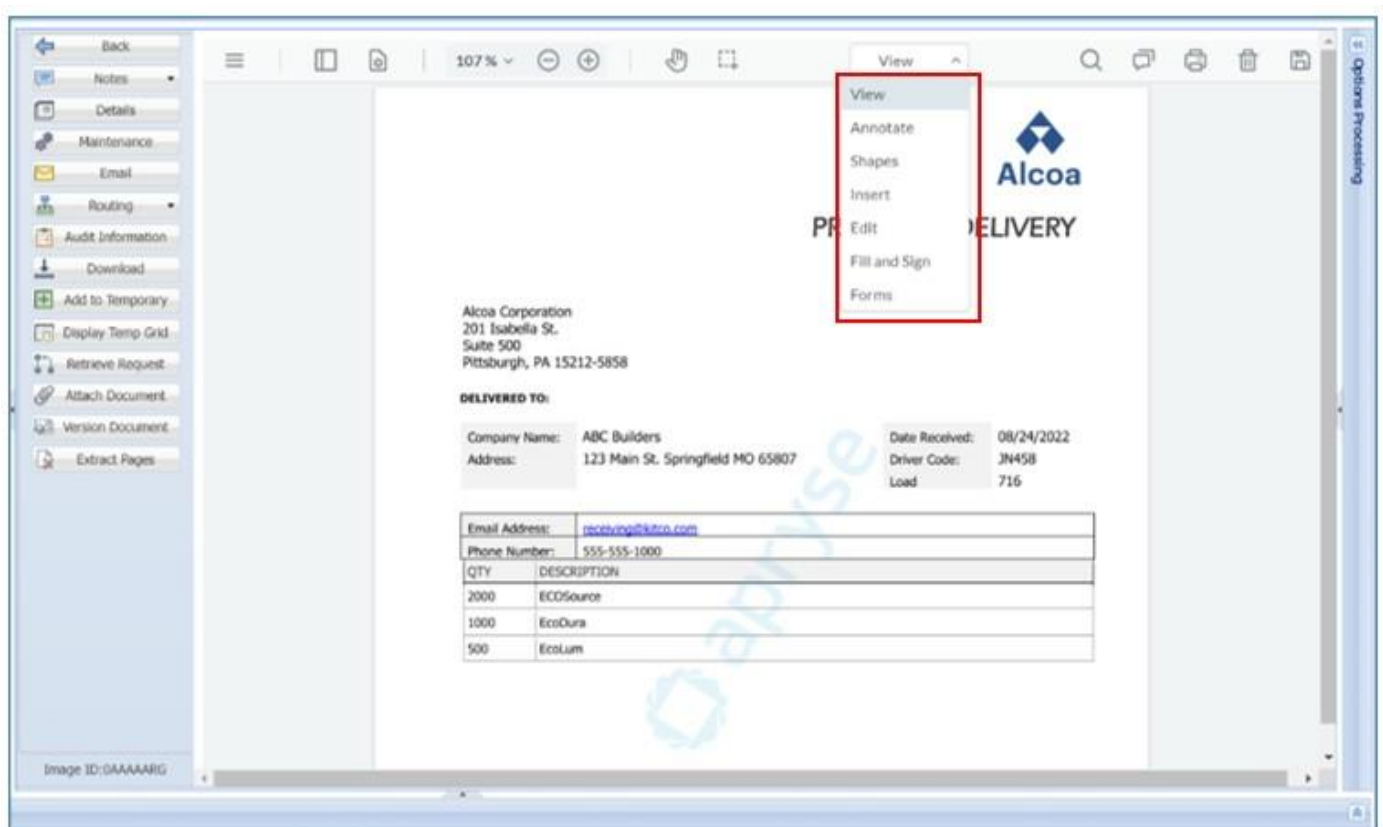


APRYSE FOR MARKUPS & ANNOTATIONS

The RVI OneLook user interface provided with Version 9.0 has been a real hit with our customers! And why not? It's browser-based (so there's no code to download), it's very user-friendly, it's fast, and the consistent look & feel across our IBM i, Windows, and Cloud systems has simplified user transitions when platform changes occur.

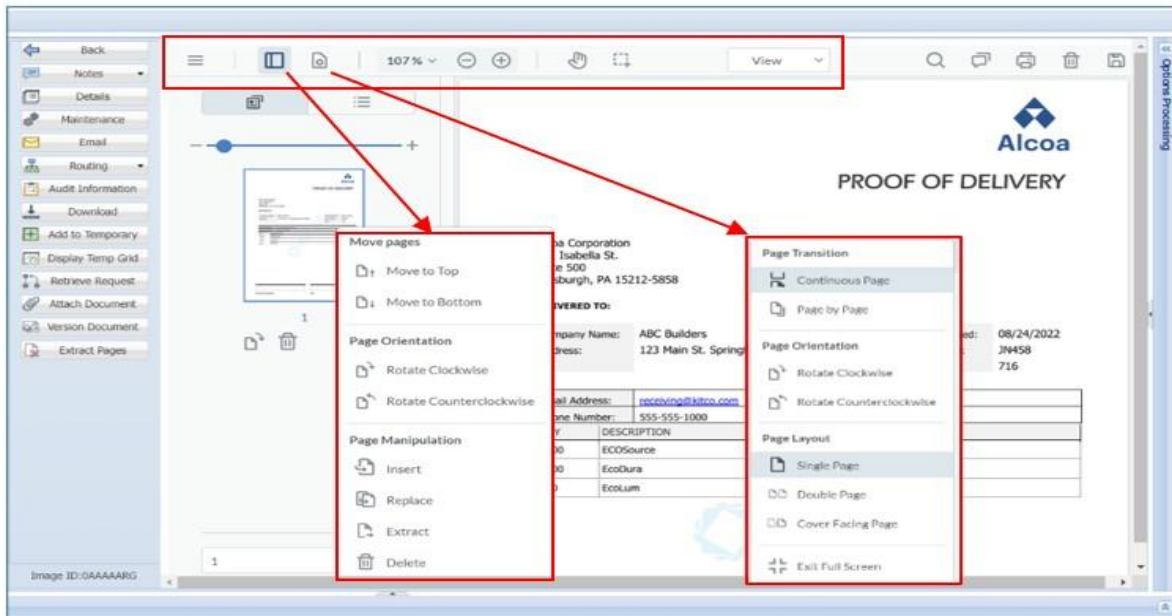
One missing piece of the puzzle has been the capability to add mark-ups and annotations to RVI documents as they are viewed and moved through the workflow process. Problem solved with the **APRYSE** browser editor that is now integrated with RVI Version 9.0. So, let's have a second look at what's new in OneLook!

With **APRYSE**, your documents will be delivered within a PDF editor loaded with new capabilities that are grouped in seven different categories:



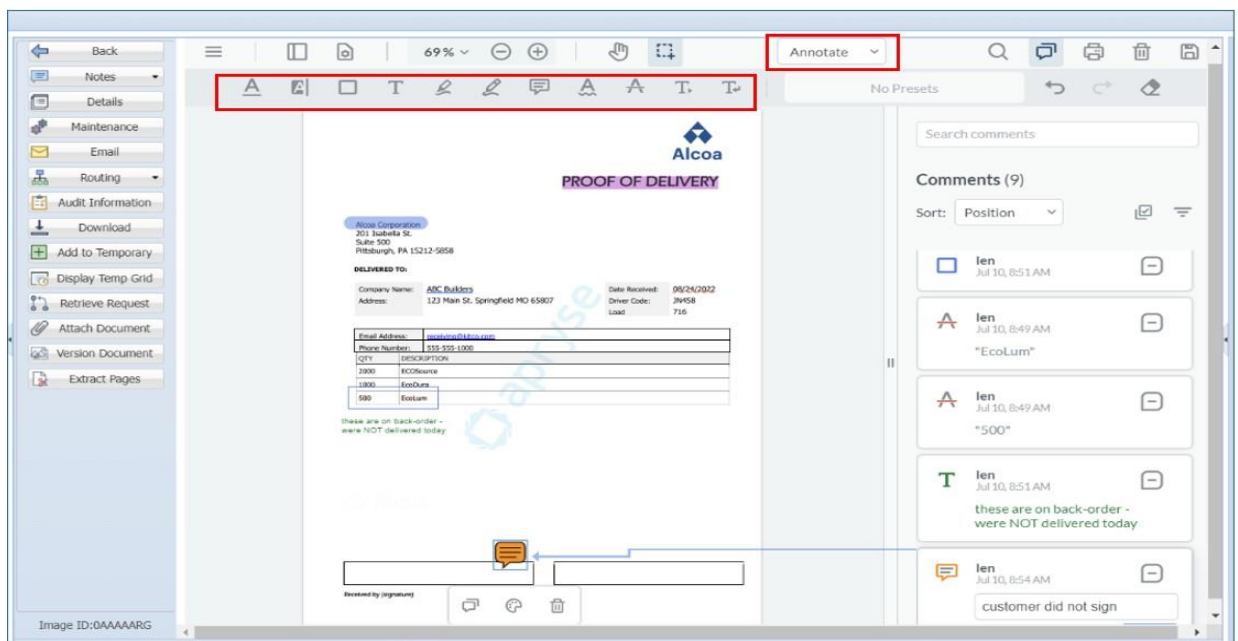
VIEW OPTION

The VIEW option is a simple task bar with a panel of page manipulation features that you would expect (move, rotate, insert, replace, extract, delete, display). Page views can be sized to your preference and a panning feature is included for your convenience.

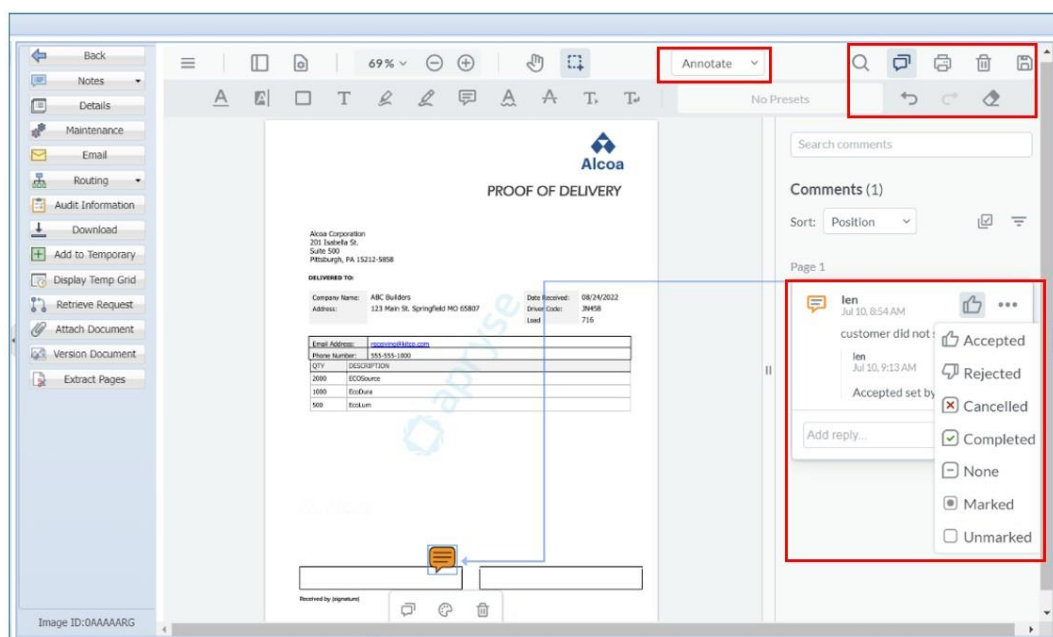


ANNOTATE OPTION

The **ANNOTATE** options allow you to highlight items, underline key points, (thin, thick, free-form, squiggly), add shapes, insert text, and add comments. You can select the font type/size, choose the colors from an extensive palate, or even link it to a website. Audits are available to show what user added which annotation to the document.

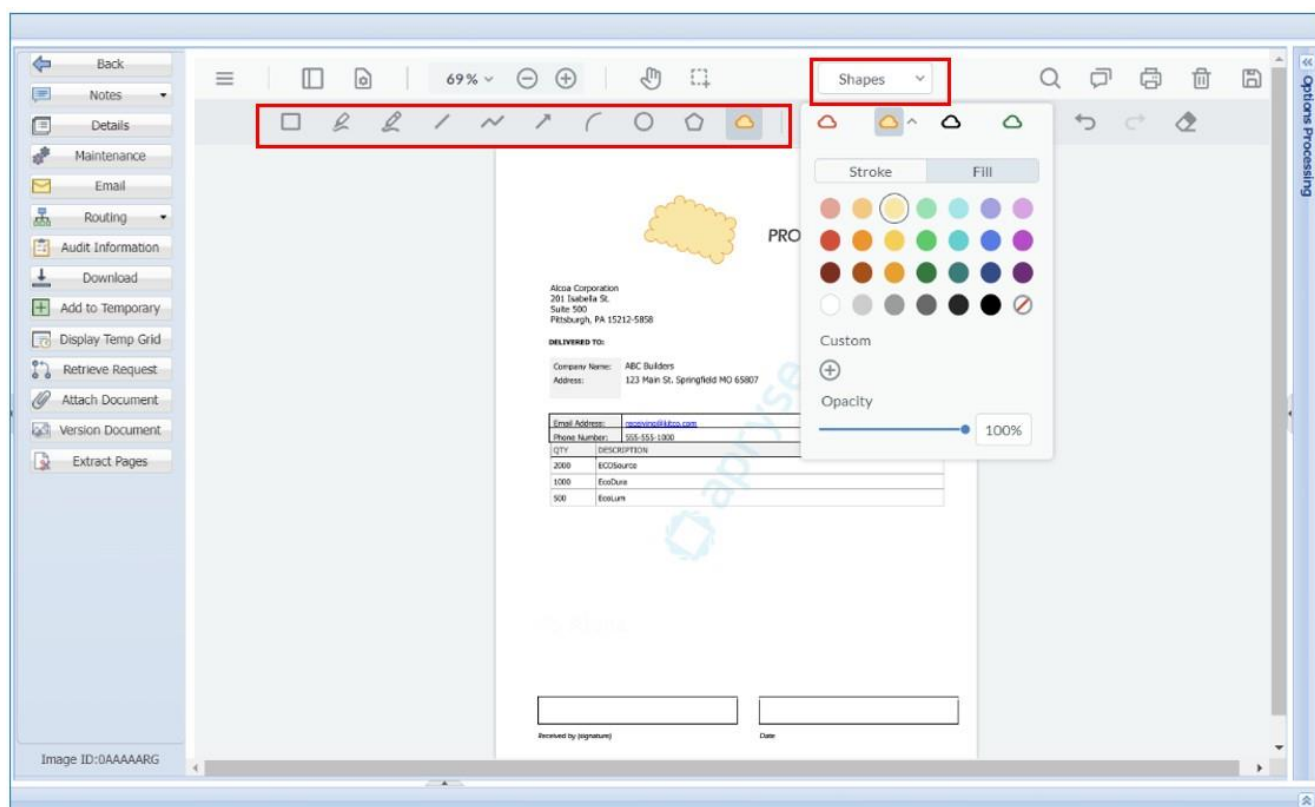


Annotations can be removed using the eraser, undo option, or trash can (on the toolbar or by clicking on an audit record). The **COMMENT** feature is collaborative such that multiple users can add to the conversation or simply select from the STATUS options provided.



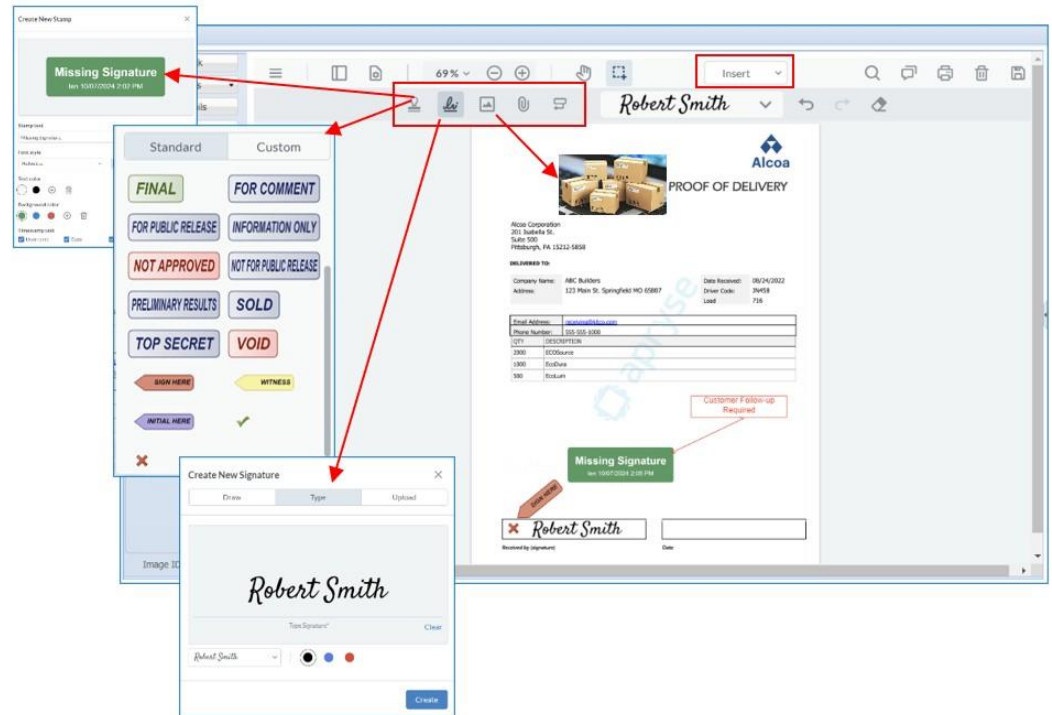
SHAPES

Other **SHAPE options** are available including lines, arrows, lightning bolts, arcs, circles, pentagons, and even a customizable cloud! Color preferences for outlines/fills for each shape can be selected.



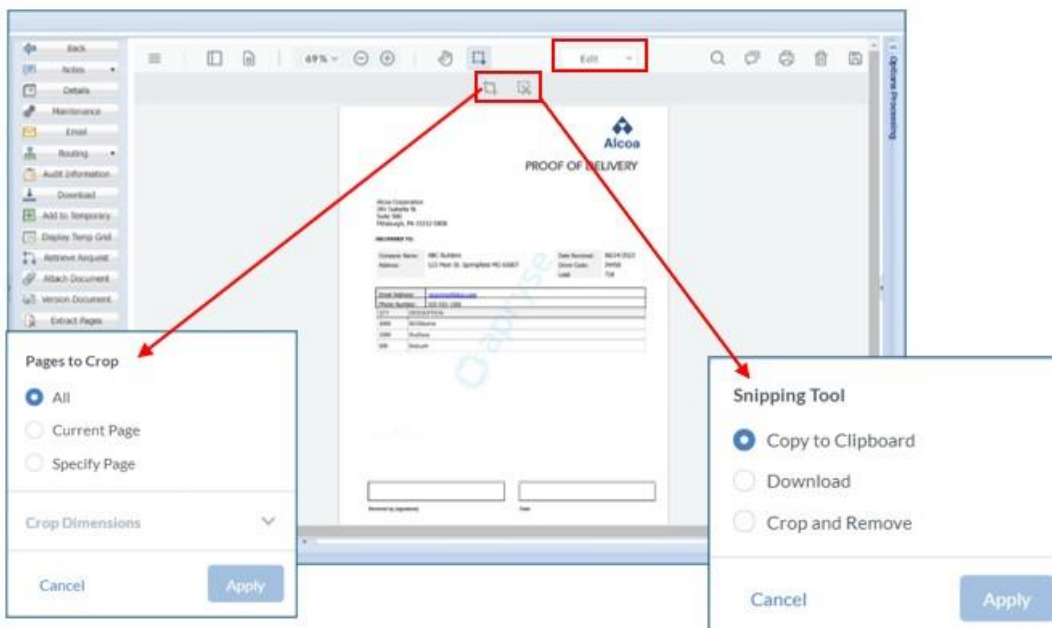
INSERT OPTION

The **INSERT options** are strong! Rubber Stamps are provided, or they can be customized as shown with the Missing Signature stamp. You can add signatures (drawn, typed or uploaded). Photos can be merged, and files can be attached. CALLOUT enables comments to be directed at a specific part of the document (such as Customer Follow-up Required).



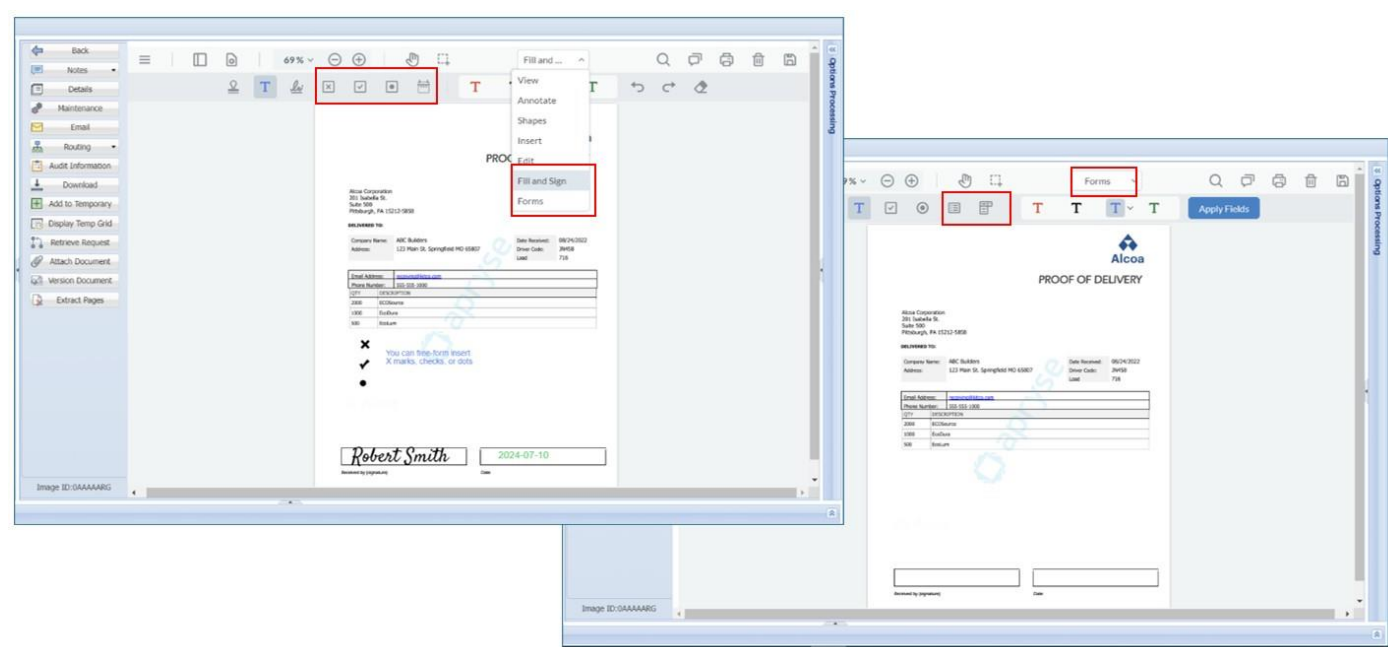
EDITING OPTION

EDITING options are available to CROP documents and a SNIPPING TOOL is included to extract relevant portions of a document that a user requires.



FILL & SIGN OPTION

FILL & SIGN options allow you to add cross-outs, check marks, or radio buttons. A customizable calendar is provided for date stamping. Itemized list boxes can be created using the additional field options on the **FORMS** toolbar.



My development philosophy has always been to build what I can to retain control of our software AND pricing. That has generally worked out well for us over the years. However, I quickly realized that APRYSE had a far more extensive view of what I thought markups and annotations were all about! This is a very good product that easily integrates with our software so why mess with a good thing!

APRYSE is an embeddable plug-in designed for software developers such as Real Vision Software. That said, it is one of the few optional items that is not included in our base software. RVI will pass the APRYSE license fee on as an annual support charge of \$1,000 which is great value for what you get.
